
WHAT IS THE RESTRUCTURE?



The Irish FA is undertaking a significant restructure of the men's football pyramid in Northern Ireland to enhance the competitiveness and sustainability of the men's amateur game

An opportunity to 'reset' the football pyramid and provide an improved pathway for ambitious clubs to be promoted to the top tiers of the amateur game, with the future potential for progression to the professional game







Introduction of a new 'Conference' layer to allow clubs to compete at a national level directly below the NIFL Premiership and Championship



Following a consultation process the Irish FA has identified a need to develop **consistent** league formats (number of teams and matches) and fixture calendar for the top tiers of the amateur game




To establish a dependable mechanism for promotion and relegation across the highest levels of men's amateur and professional game

Improve the quality of football facilities and spectator experience via enhanced ground criteria and invest €1million in club facilities




AN OPPORTUNITY FOR AMBITIOUS CLUBS

Performance Game

Aspirations to progress through the pyramid and continually compete at the highest level of competition possible and play on a national basis.



Clubs will be requested to self identify if they consider themselves as a Performance club who wish to participate in the **Performance Game pathway** or are a club with a philosophy based on participation wishing to remain within the Everyday Game structure.




Everyday Game




RESTRUCTURE OF MEN'S FOOTBALL PYRAMID
